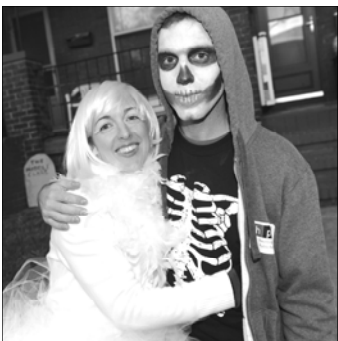


HAUNTINGDON AVE 2011
