Getting Police reports for the Remington area

Police and crime statistics have not been in the Newsletter for a couple years, but it was asked the other day how to find them for the neighborhood. You can check on crime statistics for Remington by going online to www.baltimorepolice.org/your-community/crime-map. Remington is part of the Northern Police District and information will be in that section.

Remember, if you need to report a crime, please remember that you can report them anonymously. You must tell them that "you wish to remain anonymous". You may also sign up for a Crime Watch ID. An ID number will be mailed to you and when you call in a crime, use that number. They will use the Crime Watch number and not your name.

The Greater Remington Improvement Association (GRIA) has entered Remington in the Clean Community Competition. Mayor Stephanie Blake and the Department of Public Works challenged the city to "Keep Baltimore Clean". Remington residents are going to make this happen in our part of the city.

Assisting in this can be as simple as sweeping the sidewalk/street in front of your house on a Saturday morning or participating in an event such as cleaning up the vacant lot at the end of the block.

Clean alleys and streets will mean less rats, less roaches and a nicer, safer place to live and play. You do not have to be a member of GRIA to help out. Everyone in Remington can do small part, and it will help as a whole.



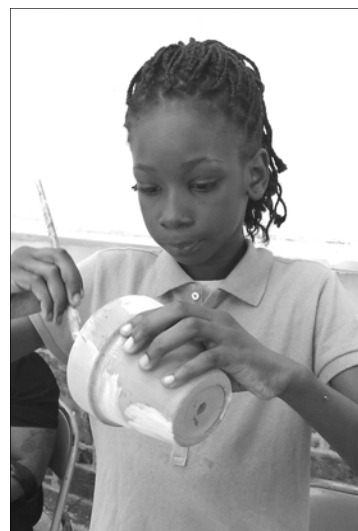

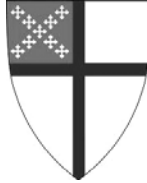
