This kind of positive media coverage with a regional audience is great news for the place we call home and can only show us what we already know about Remington: that it's a fantastic place to live, work and play.

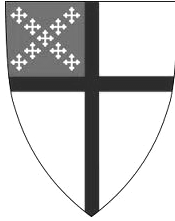
