Avoid losing your house in May Tax Sale

Are you behind on property taxes or water bill?

Do you have delinquent taxes that are unpaid from last July or delinquent water bills great than \$350? There is help!

If you do not pay these bills by April 30th, your home will be included in the tax sale in May 2014.

There are non-profit organizations that can help. If you are interested in receiving FREE legal advice about tax sale and/or foreclosure contact Pro Bono Resource Center of Maryland at (443) 703-3052.

BGE Smart Meters for your Home



BGE Smart Meters—If you have not had one installed, there will be a fee of \$75 and then a monthly charge of \$11 after that.

The Public Service Commis-

sion ruled that customers that do not want the Smart Meter installed will be charged these fees.

You can call BGE at 1-800-685-0123 and they will direct you to someone to talk to about the information and about getting a Smart Meter if you have reconsidered and want one installed.

If BGE does not hear from you, then it will be assumed that you want to keep your current meter and you will be charged. BGE will begin billing customers who opted out of getting the Smart Meter after July 2014.

Ibello Upholstery, located on Fawcett Street, is one of Baltimore's premier upholstery shops.

In addition to covering old furniture with new fabric, Ibello also builds new furniture and has a full carpentry shop.

They are considered among interior designers as the best place for custom furniture in the entire region. Ibello's work can be seen in homes, restaurants and businesses all over Baltimore, but their reach also extends into Virginia, Washington, Pennsylvania, New York and Delaware. To get started, come to the Guardian Angel food pantry on Wednesday mornings and speak to Betsy Childs or call 410 -366-6200.


