What's New in Remington -Development Updates

Here is some recent news about all the exciting projects happening in Remington:

Price Modern's \$6 million renovation at 2604 Sisson is wrapping up. The company's 100+ employees now have a world-class showroom and design space, with large windows and commanding views.

Seawall Development's Remington Row office, retail and apartment project was reviewed by the Planning Commission on August 7th. The project includes Remington Avenue between 27th and 29th. If approved, construction would begin later this year.

The former Remington Wash building at 2847 Huntingdon is being renovated into a laundromat with several apartments above.

Several houses are currently under construction, including 2602 Miles, 2656-58 Miles and 302 W. 28^{th.}

Many famous people have Conservation Technology products installed at their homes, including Bill Gates, Al Gore and numerous Hollywood actors. Here in Baltimore, they provided the weather stripping for the Transamerica Tower, the city's tallest building.
